## FORMAT, INFORMATION AND DUTIES FOR MASHONALAND GALAS

## ALL GALAS WILL BE RUN IN ACCORDANCE WITH FINA RULES (AS STATED IN THE FINA HANDBOOK)

## A. ELIGIBILITY

Every gala is open to all swimmers registered with the Mashonaland Amateur Swimming Board through an affiliated body. As part of its contribution to the development of swimming in Zimbabwe, the Mashonaland Amateur Swimming Board may invite other Provincial Boards to enter swimmers, registered with their Board and the Zimbabwe Aquatic Union, in some or all of the galas staged by the Board.

Also as part of its contribution to the development of swimming in Zimbabwe, MASB may allow schools to enter swimmers in the junior and senior galas at an entry charge of $\$ 5$ per swimmer per gala. If these swimmers wish to participate in championships they would need to affiliate themselves to Mashonaland and ZSBC and pay the full affiliation fees, no matter when this is paid, and the once off fees will NOT be considered part of this payment.

Independent/Foreign Swimmers - these swimmers have to be registered swimmers with a registered club and must have obtained clearance from that club to participate in any MASB gala. A charge of $\$ 5 /$ gala will be levied as well as any championship fees which are applicable. These payments will be the individual swimmer's responsibility.

## B. AGE GROUPING

## Senior League

Age groups will be based on AGE AT 31ST DECEMBER of the year in which the event is being swum. The age groups are:

Swimmers may only swim up in a higher age group for ' $A$ ' team relay events and then only in the next highest age group. A maximum of 2 swimmers may swim up in any relay.

## Junior League

Age grouping will be based on AGE AT THE $1^{\text {ST }}$ DAY OF THE GALA. If an entrant's birthday falls on this day, the age the entrant turns that day is used to determine age group. The age groups for 2011/2012 are:

For Individual Events
8 and Under (except IM)
9 and Under
10 and Under
11 and Under

Relay Age Groups
8 and Under
9 Year old
10 Year old
11 Year old

If a swimmer changes age group during the season and as a result is not able to compete in a particular event at the higher age group (i.e. event changes from 1 length to 2 lengths), that swimmer may be permitted to swim up in the higher age group for the express purpose of recording a time for selection for the National Junior Championships in that event. In this situation, a written application (which must include the swimmer's date of birth, and must be made by the club or school coach) must be made to the MASB Results Convenor with the gala entries. If permission is granted, no points will be awarded if the swimmer were placed. Club coaches are to revise this as soon as the National Junior Championship dates are confirmed.

## C. FORMAT OF GALAS

## THE ONE START RULE WILL APPLY TO ALL GALAS (FINA RULE SW 4.4)

## SEEDED GALAS AND ONE DAY SHORTCOURSE GALA

1. These galas will be swum as boys and girls combined, on a seeded basis. Results are separated into relevant age groups, i.e. 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, $15 / 16$ \& 17/over, and gender. A swimmer must have turned 9 by 31 December of the calendar year in which the gala is held. For the one-day Short course age groups will be 12 and under, 13/14, 15/16 \& 17/over. (9/10 will be ONLY for 50 m events)
2. There will be no finals, and events will be swum in heats with entries seeded in accordance with the swimmers' previous best time. For each event the seeding, as there are no finals involved, will be such that the eight fastest swimmers are grouped in the final heat, the next eight fastest in the second last heat and so on until all swimmers have been allocated to a heat; except if there are less than three swimmers in the slowest heat, the slowest swimmers in the next slowest heat shall be allocated a place in the slowest heat, until that heat contains three swimmers.
3. The Mashonaland Board reserves the right to reduce the number of swimmers in heats below the normal eight if there are insufficient timekeepers available to adequately cover eight lanes.
4. Results based on times recorded, will be published by event and age group.
5. Swimmers will be limited to a maximum of 4 swims per seeded gala only

## MASHONALAND CHAMPIONSHIPS AND SHORTCOURSE INVITATIONAL GALA

1. The galas will be swum as boys and girls, on a seeded basis. Results are separated into relevant age groups, i.e. 12 and under, 13/14, 15/16 \& 17/over. (9/10 for 50m events ONLY) A swimmer must have turned 9 by 31 December of the calendar year in which the gala is held.
2. All heats will be swum on a seeded basis as per FINA RULE SW 3.1 - circle seeding.
3. Seeded finals will be swum such that the eight fastest swimmers are grouped in the final heat, the next eight fastest in the second last heat and so on until all swimmers have been allocated to a heat; except if there are less than three swimmers in the slowest heat, the slowest swimmers in the next slowest heat shall be allocated a place in the slowest heat, until that heat contains three swimmers.
4. Finals will be swum by age group based on the fastest eight qualifiers and two reserves provided that, where less than eight swimmers qualify over all age groups for any given event, the respective age group finals shall be swum as a seeded final, at the referees discretion.
5. Awards will be made to swimmers and relay teams placed first, second and third. Clubs may enter more than one relay team per event at the Boards discretion. Swimmers may swim their own age relays and one age group up to complete a relay for a club team in order for them to be able to enter an ' $A$ ' team. A maximum of 2 swimmers may swim "up" in any relay. All teams are eligible for awards, but only ' $A$ ' teams are eligible for points. Entries to be in 48 hours before the start of the gala.

## JUNIOR LEAGUE GALAS

1. All events will be swum as seeded finals by age group and gender and results will be published as such. Except the Individual Medley which will be swum mixed age and gender to acclimatise juniors into the senior format.
2. Clubs may enter two or more relay teams, provided there are spare lanes and at the referees discretion. Mixed gender relay teams will be allowed although no points will be scored for any relays swum. Swimmers may only be swum up to make an "A" relay and ONLY one age group. Not more than 2 swimmers may be swum up.
3. Please note a maximum of three (3) individual events may be swum. No 8 year olds may enter the Individual Medley unless they turn 9 years before the start of the Junior Nationals.

## MASHONALAND JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

1. For each individual event, for each age group and gender there will be heats and finals. Seeding will be as per FINA RULE SW 3.1 - circle seeding. The eight fastest swimmers in the heats and two reserves will qualify for the final.
2. The swimmers and relay teams that are placed first, second and third in the finals will be given awards. Boys and girls relay teams will be swum separately.
3. Clubs may enter two or more relay teams provided there are spare lanes and at the Referees discretion but points will only be awarded to ' $A$ ' teams placed. However ' $B$ ' relay teams will be eligible for awards. Swimmers may only "swim-up" for an ' $A$ ' relay and only one age-group. A maximum of 2 swimmers may swim "up" in any relay.
4. The Junior League Trophies will be presented at the completion of the Championships to the girl's team, the boy's team and the overall club team with the highest aggregate of points for the five Junior League Gala's and the Junior Championships.

Scoring for all of the above galas, where points are awarded, will be as follows:

## D. ENTRY PROCEDURES

1. Entries should be prepared on the "Team Manager" computerized swimming team management system and submitted, by e-mail, to the relevant Results Convener at least 48 hours before the gala.
2. The closing time for late entries and scratchings will be 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the gala. These events will not be re-seeded. This rule will be strictly adhered to.
3. For relay events, the following details must be recorded on the tickets:

- Club name and 'A' or 'B' team
- Age group
- Event number
- Names and order of swimmers in each relay

4. Lane draws for relay events will be seeded on entry times. Swimmers must report to the marshal in the designated area two events in advance of their event.

## E. SCRATCHINGS

1. Should a swimmer fail to report for an event for which they have been entered, they will be fined. Scratchings from events must be carried out by the coach and should be done 30 minutes before the gala commences.
2. In the case of the Mashonaland Championships, if a swimmer who has entered does not report for a race, be it a heat, a final or a relay, a fine of $\mathbf{\$ 1 0}$ per event will be imposed. The swimmer will be eliminated from further competition in individual events (be it a heat, final or relay) until this fine has been paid. Any scratchings from finals are to be carried out by the coach within 30 minutes of the results being posted.
3. These penalties may be waived at the Board's discretion, should the swimmer present a doctor's certificate or give adequate grounds for not reporting on time.

## F. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

FINA RULES GR 9.2 AND GR 9.3 will apply. Protests must be submitted in writing with a deposit of $\$ 10$ to the Referee and must be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted.

## G. CLUB DUTIES

All clubs need to organize the requested number of timekeepers in advance of the gala.
The duty club is responsible for the following:

1. Manning the entrance gate/gates and accounting for takings. These persons are to be at the gate/gates in good time (at least 1 hour before start of gala). The gate is to be manned until interval except at Championships where the gates must be manned for the duration of the gala.
2. Gate takings are to be handed to the Treasurer of the Mashonaland Board (or in his or her absence, any other member of the Mashonaland Amateur Swimming Board).
3. Provide persons to perform the following tasks.
a. Runner (taking the timekeepers sheets to the computer room)
b. Lane and heat allocation where this is not computerized.
c. Supplying teas to officials and invited guests.
d. Assisting by providing Marshals in advance of the start of the gala.

## H. FEE STRUCTURE

a. Spectator Season Tickets (allowing entry into all Mashonaland Galas including Championships) will be $\$ 15$ for the season. This does NOT include National Galas, i.e. Sprint Gala, Junior and Senior Nationals
b. Gate Fee entrance into all galas (for non season ticket holders) $\$ 5$ per session
c. Children under 12 and Pensioners free of charge.
d. MASB Affiliated swimmers spectating at galas are also free of charge.
e. Entry fees for swimmers for Senior Mashonaland Championships will be $\$ 10$ and for Junior Mashonaland Championships will be \$5.
f. Entry fees for swimmers at Mutare Sprint will be $\$ 5$ and Junior and Senior Nationals will be $\$ 10$. Spectator entry fees will be advised prior to the gala.

## I. TIME STANDARDS AND MASHONALAND SELECTION

1. As part of the criteria for selection onto the Mashonaland team to swim at the Nationals, swimmers should have swum individual events in at least two Seeded Galas and Mashonaland Championships, or in the case of juniors, swum in at least two Junior League
galas and the Mashonaland Junior Championships. Valid excuses such as medical reasons should be submitted in writing with supporting documentation, to the MASB Chairman before the relevant Mashonaland Championships for consideration for exemption.
2. Junior swimmers only joining a club after the end of the calendar year will be required to swim in one Junior League and the Mashonaland Junior Championships to qualify for consideration for the Mashonaland Junior Team. A letter from the Clubs must be produced to the Mash Board before the Mashonaland Junior Championships informing the board of these swimmers.
3. Senior swimmers that have not swum in Senior Mash Champs are not eligible for selection for Senior Nationals unless they are representing their school or country in another sporting discipline at/during the entire time of the Championships. A letter from the relevant Team Manager will be required well in advance of the Championships. Letter to be produced at the $5^{\text {th }}$ Senior Seeded Gala.
4. In the case of the Combined Harare Schools swimmers, the same criteria will apply. They will also be required to affiliate to a Mashonaland club and Mashonaland Province before being considered for selection on the Mashonaland team.
5. The 200 Butterfly, 400 Individual Medley and the 800 and 1500 Freestyle events will cater for swimmers $12 /$ over who wish to participate. These will be swum as $14 /$ under and $15 /$ over. No entry qualifying times for the Mashonaland Championships will apply but qualifying times will apply for Nationals.

## J. AWARD OF MASHONALAND COLOURS

1. Colours' points are awarded to swimmers at Senior Nationals only as below:

| Position | Points |

2. Colours are awarded once 50 points have been reached. They are the re-awarded for every further 50 points. Points may be carried through from one season to the next.

## K. OFFICIALS

In 1998, the Zimbabwe Aquatic Union (ZAU) provided a brief for the development of a swimming association and the development of swimming officiating in Zimbabwe. This association is called the Swimming Officials Association of Zimbabwe (SOAZ). In order to bring up to date and continue with this development, it is important that swimming boards / clubs encourage current officials to progress and new officials to become qualified.

The following is a list of swimming official posts (with the relevant minimum qualifying age) that fall under SOAZ :

- Timekeeper (Age 13+)
- Chief Timekeeper (Age 16+)
- Judge - Inspector of Turns and Strokes (Age 16+)
- Starter (Age 16+)
- Referee (Age 18+)
- Clerk of Course - often referred to as Marshall (Age 18+)
- Announcer
- Desk Control/Computer

The first step in officiating is to become a qualified timekeeper.
Except for Announcer and Desk Control/Computer, qualification is by exam. It is recommended that a person work six sessions prior to writing the relevant exam. Announcer and Desk Control/Computer are qualified by practical experience and performance.

For more information regarding officiating, please contact your Club Rep or your Provincial Official Convener.

## L. TIMEKEEPING

The following shall apply equally to Junior and Senior Galas

## 1. General Rules

- Timekeepers must sign on/off for their OWN stopwatch only.
- Timekeepers may only start/stop their own designated stopwatch.
- The Initial and surname of each timekeeper must be recorded on each time-sheet. The Head lane timekeeper must sign each time sheet.
- The Chief Time-keeper must assign ONE person (head lane time-keeper) in each lane to observe turns and a different person in each lane to take splits if required.
- Coaches to advise the Chief Time-keeper AND the Referee of any record attempts by swimmers
- If there are insufficient "qualified" timekeepers the Chief Time-Keeper will make every effort, where possible, to accommodate a swimmer going for a record.

2. Recording of Official Times

The Official Time shall be obtained as per FINA Rule SW 11.
a) For Manual timekeeping ( 3 unlinked digital stop-watches):

The following shall apply where there are not 3 qualified Timekeepers as per FINA rule 11.3

- A floating qualified timekeeper(s) (appointed by the Referee or Chief Timekeeper) may replace an unqualified timekeeper(s) in a lane.
- A Chief Timekeeper's or Check Timekeeper's time may be used to replace an unqualified timekeeper's time on a time-sheet.
b) For semi-automatic timekeeping (Dolphin system)

These times take precedence over the manual times unless there is a semi-automatic equipment failure

## N. DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES <br> Please refer to the separate ZAU Disciplinary Code issued in 2012

## O. MARSHALLING PROCEDURES

1. The marshalling area is for RELEVANT swimmers (swimmers swimming in the upcoming heats/events) and the nominated marshals ONLY. No parents, friends, siblings, etc are allowed into the marshalling area. Coaches may go into the marshalling area if requested (e.g. to assist the marshals with relays junior league).
2. Swimmers are to arrive in the marshalling area according to the following criteria :

- Junior League - AT LEAST 5 races in advance
- Seeded Galas - AT LEAST 10 minutes prior to the start of their race (responsibility of the swimmers/coaches to determine this time from the "heat sheets".
Swimmers arriving late to the marshalling area will not be permitted to swim. The definition of late is at the discretion of the marshals on duty.

3. If a new swimmer requires a "helper", that helper may take the swimmer to the marshalling area, hand him/her over to the relevant marshal and then must LEAVE. They cannot stay to "hold the new swimmer's hand", look after their belongings etc.
4. Once a swimmer has been marshaled (ticked off on the marshals heat sheet), they MAY NOT LEAVE the marshalling area. The marshals will cross the swimmer's lane off on the marshalling ticket if a swimmer leaves and this will mean that the swimmer will not be allowed to swim. Swimmers must ensure that they have all their swimwear (one swimsuit, cap and goggles - ear/nose plugs are permitted) before they arrive at the marshalling area.
5. Once a swimmer is seated he/she may not leave his/her seat until sent to the start (except when told to move to the next row).
6. There must be QUIET in the Marshalling Area at all times so that the marshals can hear the role call.
7. Swimmers are to answer the marshals when their names are called. Swimmers must not assume the marshals know who they are, and that after they are ticked off on the heat sheet they do not need to listen to the marshals. If you do not answer, the marshal can assume you have not arrived/left and not tick you off on the marshalling ticket.
8. Swimmers are permitted to take IPODs or similar electronics into the marshalling area, but the following applies :

- It is the swimmer's responsibility to ensure that they are able to hear the instructions given by the marshals
- The music etc must not distract any of the other swimmers or be audible to the other swimmers/marshals
- The marshals are not responsible for looking after your electronics and you may NOT bring another person into the marshalling area so that they can take/look after your belongings once you go to swim.

9. MARSHALS must ensure that ONLY one heat/race of swimmers is waiting at the start end of the pool (this is to ensure that swimmers do not accidently swim in the incorrect heat). Rule of thumb:
For 1 length events - when the one race is lined up behind their blocks, the next race can be sent to the start;
For 2 or more length events - when the race before is in the water and the fastest swimmer has 2 lengths left to complete, then the next race can be sent.
10. SWIMMERS - when waiting by the starter/or behind the timekeepers/in your lanes behind the turn judges before the start of your race:

- You must be quiet at all times.
- You are encouraged to remained robed (tracksuit/gown etc) while waiting especially if it is cold. You are encouraged to put your cap and goggles on at this stage. (adjusting cap, costume, or goggles when on the starting block may constitute delaying the start, resulting in disqualification). When you are lined up in your lanes and the Referee blows the short ready whistles that is your invitation to de-robe. The Referee will wait (within reason) for you to derobe.

11. For ALL GALAS (INCLUDING JUNIOR LEAGUE). The baby pool is out of bounds while the gala is in progress. The marshals at junior league are not baby-sitters and are not able to watch children in the pool. The alternate competition pools can be used by the competitors only for cool-downs. The diving boards are STRICTLY out of bounds at all times.

## Please note: <br> Should a swimmer wish to move clubs at any stage of a Season a clearance letter must be obtained from the club they are leaving.

Swimmers affiliated to a Mashonaland Club at the start of the season are required to swim for Mashonaland for the entire season. Swimmers wishing to change provinces at the beginning of the season, are required to get clearance from the province they are leaving.

## IMPORTANT POOL DECK NOTICES APPLYING TO ALL MASHONALAND GALAS:

1. Consumption of alcohol by officials is not encouraged.
2. Spectators are not permitted on pool deck at all and this includes the time-keepers area.
3. Swimmers are not permitted on pool deck unless they are competing in the current event/heat. Competitors waiting for the next event/heat must stay behind the officials at the ends of the pool (this includes the time-keepers at the one end and the turn judges at the other).
4. No smoking is permitted on pool deck or the marshalling area or stands.
5. Only Mashonaland stop-watches are to be used by officials. Only one stop-watch may be used by each official at any time unless instructed to do so otherwise by the Referee.
6. All cell phones on pool deck must be switched off or set to silent mode. The use of cell phones on pool deck during a session of a gala is to be discouraged.
7. In the interest of the swimmers, there must be silence for the start of a race.
8. All members or persons associated to Mashonaland Swimming must ensure and maintain the highest level of professionalism in the sport.
9. Officials Dress Code: White shirt (preferably a "golf shirt") and navy/black shorts/longs/skirt.

## ZIMBABWE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS - GENERAL RULES

## A. NATIONAL SPRINT GALA - MUTARE (SATURDAY 20 OCTOBER, 2012)

- The National Sprint Gala in Mutare Municipal pool will begin on Saturday 20 October at 9:00am. The Sprint events (i.e. 50 m of each stroke) will be swum as mixed seeded heats, with finals swum by age group and gender
- Sprint Gala age groups will be swum as $10 / \mathrm{U}, 11 / 12,13 / 14,15 / 16$ and $17 /$ Over In the event of less than three finalists in an age group, the swimmers concerned may opt to use their heat times as their final time in order to avoid re-swimming the final in that event, with so few finalists.
- No qualifying times will apply. Entries to be represented by Clubs and swimmers to wear their Club Tracksuits.
B. NATIONAL SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS - HARARE (22-26 FEBRUARY, 2013 tbc)
- No qualifying times will apply, except for those events as listed in Table A below. These times may be waivered at the discretion of the ZSBC Board prior to the event should there be free lanes available in order of ranking. Entries Convener needs to be informed of intention to participate at the pre-tournament meeting.
- Swimmers must have a previously swum time to enter for an event. These times will have to have been achieved in the current season (ie from 1 September ). A "NT" (no previous time recorded) will not be acceptable for entry to any event.
- In respect of the events listed below, entry qualifying times will apply and are as shown in Table A. These times will have to have been achieved in the current season prior to the entry deadline for the Nationals. In the event of free lanes in the final, the swimmers with the closest time to the cut off times may participate. Advance request is to be given with original entries submitted to Results convenor.
- In all senior national events age groups will be 12/U, 13/14, 15/16, 17/Over. Age date as at $31^{\text {st }}$ December. The National Senior Championships will be swum over $41 / 2$ days, starting Thursday afternoon and ending the following Monday. Heats will be swum as mixed seeded events. Finals will be swum by age group and gender. Long distance events ( $400 \mathrm{~m}, 800 \mathrm{~m}, 1500 \mathrm{~m}$ freestyle, 400 m IM, 200 m butterfly) will be swum as timed finals.

## TOURING TEAMS - GENERAL RULES

## A. INTER-CLUB TOURS

1. Criteria will be as laid down by the host country. No adjustments will be made by ZSBC. Clubs/Provinces may determine their own selection criteria as long as they are not less than the host country's requirements.
2. Selection will be by Club/Province, but must be based on times obtained at official meets and recorded on National Database.
3. Only those times reflected on original and unaltered copies of computer generated result sheets and seeding lists, will be considered by Swim SA. All Provinces/Clubs are therefore required to have access to computer based result systems and are to ensure that all respective results have been correctly processed through such facilities.
4. Qualification times to be used for selection are those that have been achieved from 1 May 2012.
5. Externally based swimmers are required to submit their times for selection consideration. These must be endorsed by their coach, confirming their accuracy.
6. Tours will be arranged and managers/coaches provided by club or province. Clubs and provinces are free to combine teams for tours.
7. Touring teams may not refer to themselves as Zimbabwe national teams, and the national colours, flag or emblem may not be used on kit.
8. No special passport requirements are in force, but full lists of touring teams detailing swimmers' names; ages, nationalities and passport numbers must be submitted to ZSBC for furtherance to ZAU and the Sports and Recreation Commission. This is for information purposes only and for obtaining clearance letters.

## B. INTERNATIONAL TOURS

1. Selection to any team will be in accordance with the criteria laid down and at the discretion of the selectors, subject to ratification by the ZSBC and ZAU.
2. All swimmers must be in possession of a valid Zimbabwe passport in order to be eligible for selection to any of the ZSBC Open Tours - details to be supplied on the ZSBC Registration Form. SA Level 3 will be swum as a Zimbabwe Team, but does not necessarily require a Zimbabwe Passport as it is an Age Group (Junior) Competition. All Open Competitions require the Zimbabwe Team members to be in possession of a valid Zimbabwe Passport.
3. Only those times reflected on original and unaltered copies of computer generated result sheets and seeding lists will be considered.
4. Externally based swimmers are required to submit their times for selection consideration. These must be endorsed by their coach, preferably on Meet Manager, confirming accuracy.
5. ZSBC is responsible for ensuring that the Selectors have available to them, current times for all swimmers and a programme of events for each tour, including criteria required by hosts prior to selection.
6. Should any individual feel that he/she has legitimate grounds for protest e.g. their own non selection, such protest must be conveyed to the Chairperson of the ZSBC. This must be done in writing (e-mail or fax transmissions are acceptable), through the respective Club Chairperson to the Provincial Chairperson, who must support such a protest, within 72 hours of the team having been officially announced. Protests made directly to the Selectors or ZSBC board will be nullified and may thereafter not be re-submitted. A deposit (\$50) must be lodged with the protest, this being forfeited should the protest be unsuccessful. The ZSBC shall meet with the Selectors as soon as possible after the expiry of the 72 -hour period after the announcement of each team, at which time any protest shall be heard and a final decision made in this regard. This meeting may be telephonic or via email/fax. Following this process, the final team will be submitted to ZAU for ratification and approval.
7. For Zimbabwe-based swimmers to be considered for tour selection, they must participate in the Senior National Championships. The only exception will be proof of participation at another sporting event where the athlete will represent Zimbabwe and proof of Sports and Recreation Commission clearance is submitted to the ZAU executive, where the dates coincide with the National Swimming Championships. In this instance, the swimmer would have to have participated at the National Sprint Gala in Mutare to be considered for Selection.

Note: Externally based swimmers are exempt from this requirement but are encouraged to take part in local galas wherever possible and to attend National Events where possible.

The submission of times for selection to participate in international events will be concluded by the following dates:

Selectors will meet as soon as possible to finalize selection for the teams soon after selection cut off date. Any times recorded or submitted after the selection panel has been convened for each tour will not be taken into account for selection purposes. However, for swimmers that have been selected, additional qualifying times achieved after the convening of the selection panel, but prior to the cut-off entry date of the relevant tour may be used to register for additional swims on that tour. Notwithstanding the above clauses detailed, the selectors may take into consideration any additional criteria as the Board may direct or as circumstances warrant, with such selection being subject to ratification by the Board of Control and ZAU.

All touring teams shall travel together unless otherwise decided by the ZSBC at its discretion. All touring teams shall stay together unless otherwise decided by the ZSBC at its discretion.

Please note that any swimmer wishing to participate in a gala outside of Zimbabwe, which is not an official ZSBC tour, MUST obtain clearance from ZSBC prior to submitting their entries.

## TOUR COACHES AND MANAGERS - GENERAL RULES

- These rules do not apply to inter-club tours.
- Full details of the criteria, requirements and expectations of tour coaches and managers are contained in an INFORMATION PACK compiled by ZSBC. Copies of this info pack are available on request.
- Coaches and managers for tours will be selected by the Selectors and ratified by ZSBC and ZAU. Selection will be based upon the ability and experience of the coach / manager relevant to the level of the tour. Coaches and managers will follow a progression plan and will not advance to higherlevel tours until they have relevant experience at lower levels.
- Selection will be based primarily upon ability. Thereafter the Selectors will take into account any tours recently conducted by an individual, with a view to developing experience of other candidates. The selectors may however nominate the candidate who in their opinion is best suited for a particular manager / coach position regardless of whether that individual has recently conducted other tours.
All coaches and managers wishing to be considered for selection are required to provide the board with curricula vitae (ZSBC have these forms ready for completion via email) and copies of any relevant certificates.
- Usually one coach and one manager will be required for tours. ZSBC may at its discretion elect to provide additional coaches and managers for large teams.
- The travel, accommodation and subsistence costs for the official coach and manager will be provided from tour funds. Accommodation and subsistence costs for additional days spent outside Zimbabwe will be covered from tour funds only if these days are unavoidable.
- Self-funding parents or club coaches who wish to accompany tours may make application to ZSBC to be considered as learner / assistant coach or manager. Where possible, applications should be accompanied by CVs and certificates. Where ZSBC elects to make available such positions, the assistants / learners will be selected by the Selectors, but funding may/may not be provided from tour funds, depending on team size.
- All selected officials and learner/assistant coaches and managers are required to be in possession of the information pack referred to above, and to familiarize themselves with it.
- In cases where tours are provided with assistant/learner coaches and managers, the qualified official coach and manager will remain in charge.
- Parents and club coaches accompanying tours who have not been selected as officials or learners/assistants are expressly forbidden from becoming involved in coaching or management issues and equally, are not be involved in travel, accommodation and Team arrangements.


## TOUR CRITERIA - GENEREAL NOTES

- The time criteria and time requirements (numbers of qualifying times) listed in the following tours are the minimum requirement for a swimmer to be considered for selection. Achievement of these criteria does not necessarily mean that a swimmer will be selected.
- The Selectors further reserve the right to include in tour teams swimmers who may not have achieved the criteria but who come acceptably close in the Selectors' opinion, or for purposes of completing a relay team.
- Detailed tour criteria appear in the following pages.
- The inter-club criteria for the SA tours are provided for information only and will not be administered by ZSBC.


## WORLD SHORTCOURSE

ISTANBUL, TURKEY
12-16 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ DECEMBER 2012

Swimmers wishing to apply for selection will need to have swum 2 of the times below in the period $1^{\text {st }}$ January 2012 - selection date. Those who have long course times that qualify will need to swim short course to obtain short course entry times but these can be achieved up to the end of October 2012, BUT they may claim their qualification on the long course times. Swimmers who have not made long course times, will need to make 2 of the short course times in the same period Jan 2012-31 ${ }^{\text {st }}$ August 2012 but may improve their times up to the end of October. NO YARDS TIMES WILL BE CONSIDERED. Conversion times have been calculated on the Swimmers World Magazine conversion facility. Qualification does not guarantee selection.

In addition to the Qualifying times the following details need to be supplied

1. Digital passport photograph (unless we already have this)
2. Digital photograph to be used for accreditation (unless we already have this)
3. Digital copy of your current Zimbabwe passport (unless we already have this)
4. Ensure that your membership for the $2012 / 13$ season is paid by September $30^{\text {th }}$.

## TO BE HELD IN HILLCREST, PRETORIA , RSA

5-7 APRIL, 2013

- This is a Club / Provincial Tour (Age Group Junior Competition), therefore any valid travel document will be acceptable for participation and travel.
- This competition is open to swimmers aged 10 years up to 16 years as at $1^{\text {st }}$ date of gala i.e. 5 April 2013. Age grouping for the competition will be 10\&U yrs, $11 \mathrm{yrs}, 12 \mathrm{yrs}, 13 \mathrm{yrs}, 14 \mathrm{yrs}, 15-16 \mathrm{yrs}$.
- Any number of swimmers per age group per event may be entered.
- THREE Level 1 qualifying time to be achieved to qualify for selection. See TABLE 2 (SA Age Group Time Standards 2012).
- 10 year-olds will be required to have at least ONE 11 YEAR-OLD LEVEL 2 qualifying time in order to participate in this gala, in addition to at least TWO other Level 110 year-old qualifying times.
- 200 IM participation - a swimmer MUST have swum at least TWO 200IMs prior to Senior National Championships
- Swimmers may enter all events that they have qualified in and three additional events as long as they have recorded time on the Data Base, as from 1 May 2012. Maximum number of swims will be 6 , excluding relays
- If a swimmer has achieved one Level 2 or Level 3 qualifying time, he/she must participate at Level 2 or Level 3 respectively. This rule does not apply to swimmers in the 10 and under age group, they may choose to compete in the 10 and under events at Level 1 or compete in the 11 and under events at Level 2.
- Selection times to be taken from 1 May, 2012.
- A preliminary Mashonaland Selection to be done on 1 February, 2013.
- The final cut-off date for times to be achieved will be in accordance with SA entry submission guidelines, and will be advised as soon as they are available.
- Official tracksuit will be Senior Mashonaland Tracksuit for Mashonaland Team.
- The Team will be under the direct responsibility of the Provincial Manager and Coach.
- Participation at Mashonaland Championships and Nationals will be required for Selection for Mashonaland Team.
- (Swimmers not residing in Zimbabwe may be exempt from this part of the Criteria as determined by each Provincial Board)

# SA NATIONAL AQUATIC CHAMPIONSHIPS \& YOUTH CHAMPS 

## TO BE HELD IN PORT ELIZABETH, RSA

14-21 APRIL, 2013

## SA NATIONALS

- This is a Zimbabwe Tour and an Open Competition (one age group), therefore a valid Zimbabwe Passport will be required for participation and travel.
- This competition is open to swimmers aged 15 years and over as at $1^{\text {st }}$ date of gala i.e. 14 April, 2013.
- Only One SA National qualifying time to be achieved to qualify for selection.
- See TABLE 3 (SA National Times 2012).
- Swimmers may enter the events they have SA National qualifying times for, plus three additional events provided they have times as from 1 May 2012.
- Provinces may enter their fastest non qualifier in an event where they do not have any swimmers with qualifying times entered.
- Selection times to be taken from 1 May, 2012.
- A preliminary ZSBC Selection to be done after the conclusion of Senior National Championships, with final selection on $\mathbf{2 0}$ March, 2013. Team to be ratified by ZAU.
- Level 3 swimmers ( 16 years and above) need to indicate by the end of February 2013, whether they will be attending this gala should they meet the required criteria at Level 3.
- Official tracksuit will be Zimbabwe Senior Open Tracksuit (Green \& White Tracksuit).


## YOUTH CHAMPS

- Swimmers in the 16-19 years age group, who have achieved one S A Youth qualifying standard may enter three additional Olympic Events, provided they have times on the SSA Database - except the 50 m Freestyle this will be subject to rule.
- There will be no qualifying times for the 50 m Youth events. Swimmers who wish to enter a 50 m Event, must have achieved a qualifying time in the 100 m or 200 m of the particular event. e.g. 50 m Butterfly, the swimmer must have qualified in either the 100 m or 200m Butterfly
- See TABLE 4
- There will be no relays in this category
- The results for the S A Youth Nationals will be determined from the heats
- The first three placed swimmers in the 16-19 years who qualified on the SA Youth QT, provided they do not fall in the SA Elite Youth awards will receive the SA Youth Medal.


## CANA ZONE 3 \& 4 INVITATION SWIMMING GALA

## TO BE HELD IN LUSAKA, ZAMBIA

APRIL 2013

- This is a Zimbabwe Tour and therefore any swimmer to be eligible for selection, must have in their possession a valid Travel Document. Zimbabwe Passport is not compulsory.
- CROCS are also eligible for selection, but will be bound by the same deposit rules and dates as specified below.
- This competition is open to swimmers aged 11 years and over.
- Age grouping for the competition will be $11 / 12,13 / 14,15 / 16,17 / \mathrm{O}$ age as at the first day of the gala.
- Only two swimmers per age group per event may be entered by each Country (CANA ruling).
- Selection times to be taken from 1 May 2012
- Exact gala dates will be made available as soon as the Board has these from CANA.
- A Minimum of Level 2 Qualifying times for age at date of gala.
- At the conclusion of all the Provincial Championships in December 2012 a "long list" will be released by ZSBC. This list is subject to ADDITIONS and SUBTRACTIONS at the discretion of the Board and its selectors at any stage after this prior to the FINAL selection being ratified.
- A deposit of $\$ 250$ MUST be lodged with the ZSBC Treasurer by the BEGINNING OF THE FINAL SESSION of Senior Nationals in order for swimmers to be eligible/considered for selection. This is NON-REFUNDABLE, for any reason whatsoever, should a selected swimmer withdraw AFTER THE CONCLUSION OF SENIOR NATIONALS.
- The deposit will be refunded to those swimmers NOT selected.
- The deposits of late-withdrawals will be off-set against tour costs for those selected.
- Only two Relay age groups to be entered - 14/Under and 15/Over.
- A FINAL ZSBC Selection to be done on 1 March 2013.
- Official tracksuit will be Zimbabwe Junior Age Group Tracksuit (Navy Zimbabwe Tracksuit).


## FINA WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

## BARCELONA, SPAIN

## 19 JULY - 4 AUGUST 2013

- Final date for Selection is 30 April 2013.
- Interested swimmers MUST apply to be considered for selection by this date, and supply any relevant times in the prescribed format.
- As was the case for Shanghai 2011, a qualifying procedure with $A$ and $B$ standard time will be implemented for Barcelona 2013.
- FINA "A" \& "B" SWIMMING QUALIFYING STANDARD TIMES
- If a National Federation enters only one (1) swimmer per event all swimmers entered must meet the qualifying $B$ standard time.
- If two (2) swimmers are entered in the same event, both of them must meet the qualifying $A$ standard time.
- Federations may enter swimmers regardless of standard time as follows:
- having no swimmer qualified: two (2) men and two (2) women; *
- having one (1) or two (2) swimmers qualified, additional swimmers up to a maximum of four (4) swimmers (two (2) men and two (2) women);* - having three (3) swimmers qualified one (1) additional swimmer provided that both genders are represented.*
* Note - Please refer to new FINA Rule BL 9.3.6.2
- Swimmers entered without qualifying time must have participated in the National Championships of the Federation. These swimmers will be allowed to enter in two (2) events each.
- Relays: $4 x 100 \mathrm{~m}$ Freestyle, $4 \times 200 \mathrm{~m}$ Freestyle, $4 x 100 \mathrm{~m}$ Medley (Men \& Women.)
- Each Member Federation may enter only one (1) team in each relay event
- The swimming qualifying standard times must be obtained at any of the competitions specified below during the period 01 July 2012 - 30 April 2013
- QUALIFYING EVENTS shall include
- Continental Championships 2012 and 2013
- International Competitions, to be approved in advance by FINA
- National Competitions, to be approved in advance by FINA
- Only swimming qualifying times achieved at competitions approved by FINA can be accepted as entry times for the 15th FINA World CHAMPIONSHIPS
