FORMAT, INFORMATION AND DUTIES FOR MASHONALAND GALAS

ALL GALAS WILL BE RUN IN ACCORDANCE WITH FINA RULES (AS STATED IN THE FINA HANDBOOK)

A. ELIGIBILITY

Every gala is open to all swimmers registered with the Mashonaland Amateur Swimming Board through an affiliated body. As part of its contribution to the development of swimming in Zimbabwe, the Mashonaland Amateur Swimming Board may invite other Provincial Boards to enter swimmers, registered with their Board and the Zimbabwe Aquatic Union, in some or all of the galas staged by the Board.

Also as part of its contribution to the development of swimming in Zimbabwe, MASB may allow schools to enter swimmers in the junior and senior galas at an entry charge of \$5 per swimmer per gala. If these swimmers wish to participate in championships they would need to affiliate themselves to Mashonaland and ZSBC and pay the full affiliation fees, no matter when this is paid, and the once off fees will NOT be considered part of this payment.

Independent/Foreign Swimmers – these swimmers have to be registered swimmers with a registered club and must have obtained clearance from that club to participate in any MASB gala. A charge of \$5/gala will be levied as well as any championship fees which are applicable. **These payments will be the individual swimmer's responsibility.**

MARLINS Swimmers – a charge of \$5 per gala will be levied per swimmer. NO Marlins swimmer may enter Mashonaland Senior or Junior Championships or the Mashonaland Shortcourse Invitational Galas. If and Marlins swimmer was a member of another club in the previous season (2012/13) they will **NOT** be allowed to enter any gala **UNTIL CLEARANCE** is obtained from that club.

B. AGE GROUPING

Senior League

Age groups will be based on AGE AT 31ST DECEMBER of the year in which the event is being swum. The age groups are:

C. FORMAT OF GALAS

THE ONE START RULE WILL APPLY TO ALL GALAS (FINA RULE SW 4.4)

SEEDED GALAS AND ONE DAY SHORTCOURSE GALA

1. These galas will be swum as boys and girls combined, on a seeded basis. Results are separated into relevant age groups, i.e. 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16 & 17/over, and gender. A swimmer must have turned 9 by 31 December of the calendar year in which the gala is held. For the one-day Short course age groups will be 12 and under, 13/14, 15/16 & 17/over. (9/10 will be ONLY for 50m events)
2. There will be no finals, and events will be swum in heats with entries seeded in accordance with the swimmers' previous best time. For each event the seeding, as there are no finals involved, will be such that the eight fastest swimmers are grouped in the final heat, the next eight fastest in the second last heat and so on until all swimmers have been allocated to a heat; except if there are less than three swimmers in the slowest heat, the slowest swimmers in the next slowest heat shall be allocated a place in the slowest heat, until that heat contains three swimmers.
3. The Mashonaland Board reserves the right to reduce the number of swimmers in heats below the normal eight if there are insufficient timekeepers available to adequately cover eight lanes.
4. Results based on times recorded, will be published by event and age group.
5. Swimmers will be limited to a maximum of 4 swims per seeded gala only

MASHONALAND CHAMPIONSHIPS AND SHORTCOURSE INVITATIONAL GALA

1. ONLY members of Mashonaland-affiliated clubs and CROCS may take part in these Championships. No MARLINS swimmers will be allowed to compete.
2. FOR MASHONALAND CHAMPIONSHIPS age groups swum will be:

50m events	10/u; 11/12; 13/14; 15/16; 17/o
100m and 200m events	12/u; 13/14; 15/16; 17/o (except 200m Fly)
200m fly	14/u; 15/16; 17/o
400m free	12/u; 13/14; 15/16; 17/o
400m IM	14/u; 15/16; 17/o
800m Free	14/u; 15/16; 17/o
1500m Free	14/u; 15/16; 17/o

A swimmer must have turned 9 by 31 December of the calendar year in which the gala is held.

3. FOR THE MASHONALAND SHOURTCOURSE INVITATIONAL age groups swum will be:

50m, 100m and 200m events	10/u; 11/12; 13/14; 15/16; 17/o	except 200m Fly
200m Fly	14/u; 15/16; 17/o	
400m Free	12/u; 13/14; 15/16; 17/o	
800M Free	14/u; 15/16; 17/o	

A swimmer must have turned 9 by 31 December of the calendar year in which the gala is held.

4. All heats will be swum on a seeded basis as per FINA RULE SW 3.1 - circle seeding.
5. Seeded finals will be swum such that the eight fastest swimmers are grouped in the final heat, the next eight fastest in the second last heat and so on until all swimmers have been allocated to a heat; except if there are less than three swimmers in the slowest heat, the slowest swimmers in the next slowest heat shall be allocated a place in the slowest heat, until that heat contains three swimmers.
6. Finals will be swum by age group based on the fastest eight qualifiers and two reserves provided that, where less than eight swimmers qualify over all age groups for any given event, the respective age group finals shall be swum as a seeded final, at the referees discretion.
7. Awards will be made to swimmers and relay teams placed first, second and third. (Mashonaland Championships only). Clubs may enter up to TWO relay teams per event at the Boards discretion. Swimmers may swim their own age relays and one age group up to complete a relay for a club team in order for them to be able to enter an 'A' team. NO swimmer may "SWIM UP" to make up a "B" relay team. A maximum of 2 swimmers may swim "up" in an "A" relay. All teams are eligible for awards, but only 'A' teams are eligible for points. Entries to be in 48 hours before the start of the gala.
8. Age Groupings will be 12/under, 13/14, 15/16, 17 & over (**50m events only for 9/10 age group**).
9. A "NO SHOW" fee of \$10 will be charged for any swimmer that doesn't swim their event. The "NO SHOW" fee will be \$40 for a RELAY team that doesn't swim.

JUNIOR LEAGUE GALAS

1. All events will be swum as seeded finals by age group and gender and results will be published as such. **Except the Individual Medley which will be swum mixed age and gender to acclimatise juniors into the senior format.**
2. Clubs may enter two or more relay teams, provided there are spare lanes and at the referees discretion. Mixed gender relay teams will be allowed although no points will be scored for any relays swum. Swimmers may only be swum up to make an "A" relay and ONLY one age group. Not more than 2 swimmers may be swum up.
3. **Please note a maximum of three (3) individual events may be swum. ONLY swimmers who will be at least 9 years old in the year of Junior Nationals ie 2014, may enter an individual medley.**

MASHONALAND JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

1. For each individual event, for each age group and gender there will be heats and finals. Seeding will be as per FINA RULE SW 3.1 – circle seeding. The eight fastest swimmers in the heats and two reserves will qualify for the final.
2. The swimmers and relay teams that are placed first, second and third in the finals will be given awards. **Boys and girls relay teams will be swum separately.**
3. Clubs may enter a MAXIMUM OF TWO relay teams provided there are spare lanes and at the Referees discretion but points will only be awarded to ‘A’ teams placed. However ‘B’ relay teams will be eligible for awards. Swimmers may only “swim-up” for an ‘A’ relay ONLY and only one age-group. A maximum of 2 swimmers may swim “up” in any relay. NO ‘swim-ups’ will be allowed to complete “B” relay teams.
4. A “NO SHOW” fee of \$10 will be charged for any swimmer that doesn’t swim their event. The “NO SHOW” fee will be \$40 for a RELAY team that doesn’t swim.
5. The Junior League Trophies will be presented at the completion of the Championships to the girl’s team, the boy’s team and the overall club team with the highest aggregate of points for the five Junior League Gala’s and the Junior Championships.

ALLOCATION OF POINTS

Scoring for all of the above galas, where points are awarded, will be as follows:

D. ENTRY PROCEDURES

1. Entries should be prepared on the “Team Manager” computerized swimming team management system and submitted, by e-mail, to the relevant Results Convener at least 48 hours before the gala.
2. NO ADDITIONAL entries will be taken at the gala for ANY swimmer who is NOT ALREADY ENTERED.
3. ADDITIONAL entries may be made for swimmers who are already entered in the particular gala up until 30 minutes before the start of the gala.
4. The closing time for late entries and scratchings will be 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the gala. These events will not be re-seeded. This rule will be strictly adhered to.

5. For relay events, the following details must be recorded on the tickets:
 - Club name and 'A' or 'B' team
 - Age group
 - Event number
 - Names and order of swimmers in each relay
6. Lane draws for relay events will be seeded on entry times.
7. Swimmers must report to the marshal in the designated area IN ACCORDANCE WITH MARSHALLING PROCEDURES (see SECTION O)

E. SCRATCHINGS

1. Should a swimmer fail to report for an event for which they have been entered, they will be fined. Scratchings from events must be carried out by the coach and should be done **30 minutes before the gala commences**.
2. In the case of the **Mashonaland Championships**, if a swimmer who has entered **does not** report for a race, be it a heat or a final, a fine of **\$10 per event will be imposed**. The swimmer will be eliminated from further competition in individual events (be it a heat, final or relay) until this fine has been paid. Any scratchings from finals are to be carried out by the coach within 30 minutes of the results being posted.
3. Also in the case of **Mashonaland Championships**, if a relay team does not report for their race as entered, a fine of **\$40 (per team)** will be imposed
4. These penalties may be waived at the Board's discretion, should the swimmer present a doctor's certificate or give adequate grounds for not reporting on time.

F. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

FINA RULES GR 9.2 AND GR 9.3 will apply. Protests must be submitted in writing with a deposit of **\$50** to the Referee and must be lodged within 30 minutes of the **results being posted**. Should the event be the last in a session, the referee and gala organisers need to be informed within 30 minutes of completion of the event.

G. CLUB DUTIES

All clubs need to organize the requested number of officials in advance of the gala.

One parent of EVERY member family will be REQUIRED to do A MINIMUM OF FOUR SESSIONS of officials duties (NOT INCLUDING TEA OR GATE DUTIES) by the 6th seeded or 5th Junior League Galas (NOT including Mashonaland Junior Championships and the Mutare Sprint Gala). Failure to do so will result in that family's swimmer/s being EXCLUDED from ALL Provincial Teams at Nationals and Level tours.

The duty club is responsible for the following:

1. Manning the entrance gate/gates and accounting for takings. These persons are to be at the gate/gates in **good time (at least 1 hour before start of gala)**. The gate is to be manned until interval except at Championships where the gates must be manned for the duration of the gala.
2. Gate takings are to be handed to the Treasurer of the Mashonaland Board (or in his or her absence, any other member of the Mashonaland Amateur Swimming Board).
3. Provide persons to perform the following tasks.
 - a. Runner (*taking the timekeepers sheets to the computer room*)
 - b. Lane and heat allocation where this is not computerized.
 - c. Supplying teas to officials and invited guests.
 - d. Assisting by providing Marshals in advance of the start of the gala.

H. FEE STRUCTURE

- a. **Spectator Season Tickets** (allowing entry into all Mashonaland Galas including Championships) will be **\$15** for the season. This does **NOT** include National Galas, i.e. Sprint Gala, Junior and Senior Nationals
- b. **Gate Fee entrance** into all galas (for non season ticket holders) **\$5** per session
- c. Children under 12 and Pensioners **free** of charge.
- d. MASB Affiliated swimmers spectating at galas are also **free** of charge.
- e. **Entry fees for swimmers** for Senior Mashonaland Championships will be **\$10** and for Junior Mashonaland Championships will be **\$5**.
- f. **Entry fees for swimmers** at **Mutare Sprint** will be **\$5** and **Junior and Senior Nationals** will be **\$10**. Spectator entry fees will be advised prior to the gala.

NOTE IN HANDBOOK – NO SWIMMER ALLOWED TO SWIM MORE THAN ONE GALA WITHOUT PAYING AFFILIATION FEES. THIS EXCLUDES SWIMMERS WHO HAVE PREVIOUSLY BEEN REGISTERED.

I. TIME STANDARDS AND MASHONALAND SELECTION

1. As part of the criteria for selection onto the Mashonaland team to swim at the Nationals, swimmers should have swum *individual* events in at least **two Seeded Galas** and **Mashonaland Championships**, or in the case of juniors, swum in at least **two Junior League galas** and the **Mashonaland Junior Championships**. Valid excuses such as a **BROKEN LIMB, AN INFECTUOUS DISEASE (eg Chicken pox, mumps etc NOT flu)** or a **SPECIALISTS' LETTER** should be submitted in writing with supporting documentation, to the MASB Chairman **BEFORE** the relevant Mashonaland Championships **FOR CONSIDERATION FOR EXEMPTION**.

2. Junior swimmers only joining a club after the end of the calendar year will be required to swim in one **Junior League** and the **Mashonaland Junior Championships** to qualify for consideration for the Mashonaland Junior Team. A letter from the Clubs must be produced to the Mash Board **before** the Mashonaland Junior Championships informing the board of these swimmers.
3. Senior swimmers that have not swum in Senior Mash Champs are not eligible for selection for Senior Nationals unless they are representing their school or country in another sporting discipline at/during the entire time of the Championships. A letter from the relevant Team Manager will be required well in advance of the Championships. Letter to be produced at the 5th Senior Seeded Gala.
4. **In the case of the Combined Harare Schools swimmers, the same criteria will apply. They will also be required to affiliate to a Mashonaland club and Mashonaland Province before being considered for selection on the Mashonaland team.**
5. The following age groups will be swum at Mashonaland Championships. No entry qualifying times for the Mashonaland Championships will apply but qualifying times will apply for Nationals.

2. Colours are awarded once 50 points have been reached. They are re-awarded for every further 50 points. Points may be carried through from one season to the next.

K. SWIMMING OFFICIALS ACCREDITATION AND PROGRESSION PLAN – 2013

This document is an update of the original Swimming Officials Progression Plan developed by Neil Bradshaw and Peter Dalzell in 1998.

The Swimming Officials Association of Zimbabwe (SOAZ) goal/mission is to conduct fair and equitable competitions for all our athletes. In an endeavour to achieve this uniformity in officiating on a national basis, the following standards have been devised for the evaluation of officials. These standards will accomplish the following :

- assure a clear and consistent knowledge of the rules
- provide sufficient time in training to assure familiarity with all levels of competition
- provide opportunity to work on pool deck and advance through the levels
- provide uniformity of officiating between provinces
- maintain knowledge of current rules

The sections below provide full details of the certification standards and procedures. Other officials' posts not included here may be provided at a later date.

Prior to the start of the 2013-2014 swimming season and prior to each season, each province will be required to submit a list of their current officials each with the officials' 'Levels of Proficiency' to the Swimming Officials Association of Zimbabwe. New officials can be added to the list during the season with the appropriate 'Level'.

The following comments and guidelines concerning the 'Accreditation System' are provided for your information and assistance.

1. All evaluations and placement on 'Levels of Proficiency' must be carried out according to the conditions specified for each category/post detailed below.
2. The prime qualification for consideration is that the individual must have attended an 'Officials' Clinic' (covering the current FINA Handbook rules for that season) conducted by an accredited Official of the respective Provincial or National association, or FINA, where the elements of training stipulated for the particular category of officiating were covered.
3. Senior National Referees and Starters will be evaluated by Pam Sainsbury and/or Neil Bradshaw in conjunction with SOAZ.
4. In future all Provinces will be required to maintain a register of all duties undertaken by officials at all meets, (it is also recommended that individuals keep their own record sheets). A table of these details must be submitted to SOAZ prior to Senior National Championships or Junior National Championships.
5. Accredited officials will retain their qualifications when moving between Provinces.
6. Provinces need to initiate their own system to encourage parents to participate.

Your co-operation in promoting and ensuring that the programme is promptly introduced in your Province will be greatly appreciated.

SWIMMING OFFICIAL CERTIFICATION AND GRADING STANDARDS AND PROGRESSION PLAN

Grading and Registration

All swimming Officials registered with the SOAZ as Timekeepers, Judges, Starters, Referees and others will be evaluated and placed on a 'Proficiency Level' according to their practical experience, swimming technical qualification and degree of competency.

Qualification

The prime qualification is the successful completion of a clinic covering the Course Module for the specific category of officiating. The clinic must be sanctioned by SOAZ and presented by an accredited Official at Provincial level. Details of the accreditation requirements for each level of the respective categories of officiating are provided below.

Accreditation

The requirements for achievement of an accreditation are the same for the respective levels of all categories of officiating in all provinces. Achievement of an accreditation will be nationally recognised.

Accreditation will lapse once an individual has failed to officiate at a swim meet at their level for a period of two years.

General

To be recognised as having worked at a meet the official must have :

- Worked at least 50% of the sessions for that meet (junior league, school meets and seeded meets qualify as one session only)
- Completed (signed in/out) the officials register for that session/meet

National Meets :

To work at a National Championship meet, the official should have worked at least 3 meets and a provincial championship meet during the current season in their official category (starter, judge etc). The allocation of officials for national meets being the responsibility of the SOAZ National Officials Convenor, and which will be based on ability/experience.

International Meets (meets outside of Zimbabwe) :

Officials attending meets outside of Zimbabwe must carry a letter of authorisation from SOAZ National Officials Convenor and thereafter ratified by Swimming Board of Control/ZAU.

TIMEKEEPER (Minimum Age 13 years)

- Have passed the Timekeepers exam

CHIEF TIMEKEEPER (Minimum Age 16 years)

- Qualified Timekeeper
- Attended a chief timekeeper's clinic/seminar

- Qualified International : Qualified National

Announcer and Desk Control/Computer are qualified by practical experience and performance

L. TIMEKEEPING

The following shall apply equally to Junior and Senior Galas

1. General Rules

- Timekeepers must sign on/off for their OWN stopwatch only.
- Timekeepers may only start/stop their own designated stopwatch.
- The Initial and surname of each timekeeper must be recorded on each time-sheet. The Head lane timekeeper must sign each time sheet.
- The Chief Time-keeper must assign **ONE** person (head lane time-keeper) in each lane to observe turns and a different person in each lane to take splits if required.
- Coaches to advise the Chief Time-keeper of any record attempts by swimmers

2. Recording of Official Times

The Official Time shall be obtained as per FINA Rule SW 11.

a) For Manual timekeeping (3 unlinked digital stop-watches):

The following shall apply where there are not 3 qualified Timekeepers as per FINA rule 11.3

- A floating qualified timekeeper(s) (appointed by the Referee or Chief Timekeeper) may replace an unqualified timekeeper(s) in a lane.
- A Chief Timekeeper's or Check Timekeeper's time may be used to replace an unqualified timekeeper's time on a time-sheet.

b) For semi-automatic timekeeping (Dolphin system)

These times take precedence over the manual times unless there is a semi-automatic equipment failure

N. CODE OF CONDUCT

All athletes, coaches, parents and officials fall under the ZAU Manual for Disciplinary and Grievance Procedure. As a FINA member federation, all persons involved in swimming are also subject to the FINA Code of Conduct.

CODE OF CONDUCT PREAMBLE (Extract from FINA Handbook By-Laws)

In accordance with the FINA Constitution Rule C 5 the first three objectives of FINA are to promote and encourage the development of Swimming in all possible manifestations throughout the world, to provide drug free sport and to promote and encourage the development of international relations.

The purpose of this Code is to guarantee that the objectives of FINA will be executed in a fair manner without disturbance and to sanction incidents, which damage the image of the FINA activities or bring them into disrepute.

This Code establishes basic regulations for fair play and moral behaviour and general discipline in all the FINA activities and covers offences committed by Members, continental organisations included, clubs, teams, officials, athletes, supporters, spectators or other persons involved in these activities.

This Code has been adopted by the FINA Bureau at its meeting in Fukuoka (JPN) on 24 July 2001, amended at the Bureau meeting in Shanghai (CHN) on 3 March 2005 and at the Bureau meeting in Montreal (CAN) on 13 July 2005.

Please refer to the ZAU “Manual for Disciplinary and Grievance Procedure” and the FINA Handbook for details.

O. MARSHALLING PROCEDURES

1. The marshalling area is for RELEVANT swimmers (swimmers swimming in the upcoming heats/events) and the nominated marshals ONLY. No parents, friends, siblings, etc are allowed into the marshalling area. Coaches may go into the marshalling area if requested (e.g. to assist the marshals with relays - junior league).
2. Swimmers are to arrive in the marshalling area according to the following criteria :
 - Junior League – AT LEAST 5 races in advance
 - Seeded Galas – AT LEAST 10 minutes prior to the start of their race (responsibility of the swimmers/coaches to determine this time from the “heat sheets”).Swimmers arriving late to the marshalling area will not be permitted to swim. The definition of late is at the discretion of the marshals on duty.
3. If a new swimmer requires a “helper”, that helper may take the swimmer to the marshalling area, hand him/her over to the relevant marshal and then must LEAVE. They cannot stay to “hold the new swimmer’s hand”, look after their belongings etc.
4. Once a swimmer has been marshaled (ticked off on the marshals heat sheet), they MAY NOT LEAVE the marshalling area. The marshals will cross the swimmer’s lane off on the marshalling ticket if a swimmer leaves and this will mean that the swimmer will not be allowed to swim. Swimmers must ensure that they have all their swimwear (**one** swimsuit, cap and goggles – ear/nose plugs are permitted) before they arrive at the marshalling area.
5. Once a swimmer is seated he/she may not leave his/her seat until sent to the start (except when told to move to the next row).
6. There must be QUIET in the Marshalling Area at all times so that the marshals can hear the role call.

7. Swimmers are to answer the marshals when their names are called. Swimmers must not assume the marshals know who they are, and that after they are ticked off on the heat sheet they do not need to listen to the marshals. If you do not answer, the marshal can assume you have not arrived/left and not tick you off on the marshalling ticket.
8. Swimmers are permitted to take IPODs or similar electronics into the marshalling area, but the following applies :
 - It is the swimmer's responsibility to ensure that they are able to hear the instructions given by the marshals
 - The music etc must not distract any of the other swimmers or be audible to the other swimmers/marshals
 - The marshals are not responsible for looking after your electronics and you may NOT bring another person into the marshalling area so that they can take/look after your belongings once you go to swim.
9. MARSHALS must ensure that ONLY one heat/race of swimmers is waiting at the start end of the pool (this is to ensure that swimmers do not accidentally swim in the incorrect heat). Rule of thumb:
For 1 length events – when the one race is lined up behind their blocks, the next race can be sent to the start;
For 2 or more length events – when the race before is in the water and the fastest swimmer has 2 lengths left to complete, then the next race can be sent.
10. SWIMMERS - when waiting by the starter/or behind the timekeepers/in your lanes behind the turn judges before the start of your race :
 - You must be quiet at all times.
 - You are encouraged to remained robed (tracksuit/gown etc) while waiting especially if it is cold. You are encouraged to put your cap and goggles on at this stage. (adjusting cap, costume, or goggles when on the starting block may constitute delaying the start, resulting in disqualification). When you are lined up in your lanes and the Referee blows the short ready whistles that is your invitation to de-robe. The Referee **will** wait (within reason) for you to de-robe.
11. For ALL GALAS (INCLUDING JUNIOR LEAGUE). The baby pool is out of bounds while the gala is in progress. The marshals at junior league are not baby-sitters and are not able to watch children in the pool. The alternate competition pools can be used by the competitors only for cool-downs. The diving boards are STRICTLY out of bounds at all times.

P. STRAPPING/TAPE

“SW 10.8 Any kind of tape on the body is not permitted unless approved by FINA Sports Medicine Committee.”

For meets within Zimbabwe, a letter from only one the following professionals will be accepted provided such letter is presented to the referee prior to the start of the meet or at the pre-tournament meeting (Nationals)

Please note:

Should a swimmer wish to move clubs at any stage of a Season a clearance letter must be obtained from the club they are leaving.

If swimmers are eligible to swim for 2 provinces i.e. parents reside in one province, but they attend school in a different province, they **MUST** select their **SPORTING PROVINCE** by the required date, and shall remain with that province for the duration of the current season, **UNLESS** a release is obtained

- seniors by 18 October 2013
- Juniors by 31 January 2014

IMPORTANT POOL DECK NOTICES APPLYING TO ALL MASHONALAND GALAS:

1. Consumption of alcohol by officials is not encouraged.
 2. Spectators are not permitted on pool deck at all and this includes the time-keepers area.
 3. Swimmers are not permitted on pool deck unless they are competing in the current event/heat. Competitors waiting for the next event/heat must stay behind the officials at the ends of the pool (this includes the time-keepers at the one end and the turn judges at the other).
 4. No smoking is permitted on pool deck or the marshalling area or stands.
 5. No glass bottles are allowed in any pool area.
 6. Only Mashonaland stop-watches are to be used by officials. Only one stop-watch may be used by each official at any time unless instructed to do so otherwise by the Referee.
 7. All cell phones on pool deck must be switched off or set to silent mode. The use of cell phones on pool deck during a session of a gala is to be discouraged.
 8. In the interest of the swimmers, there must be silence for the start of a race.
 9. All members or persons associated to Mashonaland Swimming must ensure and maintain the highest level of professionalism in the sport.
 10. Officials Dress Code: White shirt (preferably a “golf shirt”) and navy/black shorts/longs/skirt.

INTER-CLUB TOURING TEAMS – GENERAL RULES

1. Criteria will be as laid down by the host country. No adjustments will be made by ZSBC. Clubs/Provinces may determine their own selection criteria as long as they are not less than the host country's requirements.
2. Selection will be by Club/Province, but must be based on times obtained at official meets and recorded on National Database.
3. Only those times reflected on original and unaltered copies of computer generated result sheets and seeding lists, will be considered by Swim SA. All Provinces/Clubs are therefore required to have access to computer based result systems and are to ensure that all respective results have been correctly processed through such facilities.
4. Qualification times to be used for selection are those that have been achieved from 1 May 2012.
5. Externally based swimmers are required to submit their times for selection consideration. These must be endorsed by their coach, confirming their accuracy.
6. Tours will be arranged and managers/coaches provided by club or province. Clubs and provinces are free to combine teams for tours.
7. **Touring teams may not refer to themselves as Zimbabwe national teams, and the national colours, flag or emblem may not be used on kit.**
8. No special passport requirements are in force, but full lists of touring teams detailing swimmers' names; ages, nationalities and passport numbers must be submitted to ZSBC for furtherance to ZAU and the Sports and Recreation Commission. This is for information purposes only and for obtaining clearance letters.

LEVEL 2 REGIONAL AGE GROUP CHAMPIONSHIPS

- This is a Provincial Tour (Age Group Junior Competition) therefore any valid travel document will be acceptable for participation and travel.
- This competition is open to swimmers aged 11/under yrs to 18 years as at 1st date of gala i.e. 20 March, 2014. Age grouping for the gala will be 11/under, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs, 16-18 yrs
- Any number of swimmers per age group per event may be entered.
- 200 IM participation – a swimmer **MUST** have swum at least **TWO** 200IMs prior to Senior National Championships
- Swimmers may enter all events that they have qualified in and **three** additional events as long as they have recorded times on the Database from **1 May, 2013**. Maximum number of swims allowed will be 6, excluding relays
- If a swimmer has achieved one Level 3 qualifying time, he/she must participate at Level 3, with the exception of 11 year olds.
- Swimmers in the 10 and under age group, who have achieved a Level 2 qualifying time in the 11 and under age group, may choose to compete in the 11 and under age group at Level 2 or compete in the 10 and under age group at level 1.
- Selection times to be taken from **1 May, 2013** (see **APPENDIX 2**)
- A preliminary **Mashonaland Selection** to be done on **1 February, 2014**.
- The final cut-off date for times to be achieved will be in accordance with SA entry submission guidelines
- Official tracksuit will be Mashonaland Tracksuit for Mashonaland Team and Matabeleland Tracksuit for Matabeleland Team. And Provincial Tracksuits for any other Provinces that wish to enter a Team separately to these two provinces.
- The Team will be under the direct responsibility of the Provincial Manager and Coach.
- **Participation at Mashonaland Championships and Nationals will be required for Selection for Mashonaland Team.**
- (Swimmers not residing in Zimbabwe may be exempt from this part of the Criteria as determined by each Provincial Board).
